AT 3:00 AM TODAY, A LOW PRESURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 615 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DE SUR (5.6N, 131.1E). NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN LUZON.
