WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dinagat Islands - particularly MalinaoInlet, and Gaas Lulet • Agusan Del Norte - particularly Lake- Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran • Surigao del Norte – particularly Surigao and Magallanes • Agusan del Sur - particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • Surigao Del Sur - particularly Cantillian, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo- Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.
