**PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, TROPICAL STORM "BASYANG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 720KM EAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (7.4N, 132.8E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80KM/H. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE WEST NORTHWEST AT 25KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.
