THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (Aurora, Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes and the eastern coast of Quezon including Polillo Island)	Cloudy skies with scattered rains	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
