THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND EASTERN SEABOARD of CENTRAL LUZON (Batanes, Babuyan Group of Islands, Cagayan, Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, Isabela and Aurora)	Cloudy skies with scattered rains	(45 - 68) / (24 - 36)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 5.0
THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (Zambales, Bataan and Palawan)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rains	(45 - 68) / (24 - 36)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 5.0
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON and of VISAYAS (Eastern Coast of Quezon including Polillo Island, Camarines Provinces, Catanduanes, Eastern Coast of Albay, Eastern Coast of Sorsogon, Northern Samar and Eastern Samar)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms	(45 - 63) / (24 - 34)	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
