I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

At 5:06 PM, 13 January 2018, a phreatic eruption occurred in Mayon Volcano. Per PHIVOLCS Eruption Notification, the estimated height of grayish ash plume is at 2,500 meters and is drifting southwest.

Traces of ashfall were found in the Municipalities of Camalig, Guinobatan, and Daraga.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

A. NDRRMC

1. NDRRM Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- Coordinated with RDRRMC V re the PHIVOLCS Eruption Notification Form for Mayon Volcano
- Disseminated information/notification thru Short Messaging System
- Prepared Emergency Alert and Warning Message (EAWM) to provide information and warning to the public regarding the eruption

2. Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS)

- Provision of Mayon Volcano Eruption Notification
- Continuous monitoring

3. Telecommunications Service Providers (ABS-CBN, GLOBE, and SMART)

Disseminated EAWM to Region V

B. RDRRMC V

1. OCD V

- Coordinated with PHIVOLCS and PDRRMC Albay re the status of Mt. Mayon
- Disseminated status of volcanic activity of Mt. Mayon to RDRRMC members and stakeholders thru SMS Text Blast

2. PDRRMC Albay

- Issued evacuation order of population within the 6-8km Permanent Danger Zone:
 - Daraga Brgys. Miisi, Banadero, Matnog
 - Camalig Brgys. Anoling, Quirangay, Tumpa, Suha, Tinubran
 - Guinobatan Brgys. Tandarora and Maninila
 - Ligao City Brgys. Baligang and Amti
 - ➤ Tabaco City Brgys. Magapo and Buang
 - Malilipot Brgys. Canaway and Calbayog
- Informed and coordinated with the affected MDRRMOs to conduct immediate assessment within their respective AOR
- Close coordination with member-agencies and PHIVOLCS for the regarding the event and possible response actions
- Sent an updates for public information via SMS and through social media to all stakeholders

3. MDRRMCs Camalig, Guinobatan, and Daraga

- Field assessment of affected areas of the Mt. Mayon Activity
- Distributed face masks to the affected population of the activity
- Implement evacuation operations of population in the 6-8km Permanent Danger Zone.
