**1. Report on Drowning Incident at Barangay Lamlahak, Lake Sebu, South Cotabato Province**

**A. Situation Overview:**

- On January 24, 2018 at around 4:40 PM, a drowning incident was reported to the Municipal DRRM Office of Lake Sebu.
- The victims were going home and passing by the riverside a large volume of water due to heavy rainfall carried them away which resulted to their death.
- Dead bodies were recovered at 5:00 AM today January 25, 2018.

**2. Progress Report on Flooding in Matalam, North Cotabato Province**

**A. Situation Overview:**

- Early morning of January 25, 2018 flooding occurred in the barangays of Poblacion, Dalapitan, Taculen and New Pandan, all of Matalam Municipality after Malamote Creek

overflowed due to continuous heavy rainfall last night of January 24, 2018 in the upstream area of Kidapawan City brought about by local thunderstorm.

- In addition, the New Pandan Elementary School and Malamote-Taculen Elementary School suspended classes since the said schools submerge to floodwaters.
