I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Tail-End of a Cold Front will continue to bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and isolated thunderstorms over **SURIGAO DEL NORTE, DINAGAT PROVINCE, BICOL REGION, AND VISAYAS**. Residents in these areas must undertake precautionary measures against possible Flash Floods and Landslides and coordinate with their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices. Meanwhile, light to moderate rains will be experienced over **the rest of Caraga and the Provinces of Aurora, Quezon and Mindoro**.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast at 4:00PM today and the next advisory will be issued at 11:00AM tomorrow.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
