I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The effect of the Tail-End of a Cold Front has weakened. Improved weather conditions will be experienced over Visayas and the Regions of Bicol and CARAGA. However, isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon or evening, should be expected in these areas due to the Easterlies.

With this development, this is the final advisory for the weather system.

However, you are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
