I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today

Location of Center	1,200 km East of Mindanao (6.8°N, 137.1°E) (Outside PAR)
Maximum Sustained Winds	55 km/h near the center
Gustiness	Up to 65 km/h
Forecast movement	West Northwest at 27km/h

This Tropical Depression outside Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) has no direct effect yet in any part of the country as of this moment. However, it is expected to enter PAR tonight and will be named "BASYANG".

Maritime operations along the eastern seabords of Visayas and Mindanao will be disrupted once Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal is raised tonight.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 01** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
