**I. Belated Report on Flashflood in Polomolok, south Cotabto Province**

**• Situation Overview**

- At about 12:30 PM on 03 February 2018, a flashflood happened in Barangay Poblacion, Polomolok, South Cotabato Province due to heavy rainfall in the upstream area of the said Municipality.
- The occurrence resulted to forced evacuation of forty-three (43) families and nine (9) families evacuated to evacuation center.
- The flood waters subsided at 3:00 PM on the same date, 03 February 2018.

**• Effects**

- A total of fifty-two (52) families/ two hundred sixty (260) persons were affected and nine (9) houses were totally damaged in Barangay Poblacion, Polomolok, South Cotabato.

**• Actions Taken:**

- MDRRMC Polomolok deployed SAR Group to conduct forced evacuation to the affected families
- LGU Polomolok distributed family food packs to most priority affected families
- Municipal Engineering Office conducted clearing operations in Maria Rosa Creek
- Municipal Engineering Office conducting damage assessment on the damaged infrastructure
