

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At **10:00 AM**, the **Low Pressure Area** (formerly Tropical Depression "Basyang") was estimated based on all available data at **220km South Southeast of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (8.1N, 119.8E)**. Latest analysis indicates that **significant re-development** of this weather disturbance into a Tropical Depression is **still likely**.

The Low Pressure Area will bring **moderate to occasionally heavy rains** over Southern Palawan while **scattered light to moderate rains** will prevail over the rest of Palawan with moderate to rough seas. Residents in these areas are advised to continue monitoring for updates, take appropriate measures against possible **flooding and landslides**, and coordinate with their respective local disaster risk reduction and management offices.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
