I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, the Low Pressure Area (formerly Tropical Depression "Basyang") was estimated based on all available data at 220km Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (8.6N, 117.1E). The weather system will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over southern Palawan. However, the LPA is expected to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) in the next 12-24 hours.

With this development, this is the final weather advisory.

However, you are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
