A pest infestation was reported in Bautista, Pangasinan caused by Armyworms (Harabas), from 10 December 2017 up to present. It resulted to crop damages on onions and is currently affecting eleven (11) barangays.

• Actions Taken:

A. RDRRMC1

OCD

- Office of Civil Defense Regional Office 1 (OCDRO1) coordinated with Bautista, Pangasinan through their Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Office for the situation update.
- OCDRO1 on continuous monitoring in the AOR.

B. P/MDRRMCS

BAUTISTA

- Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) of Bautista, Pangasinan conducted information dissemination about Armyworms (Harabas).
- Close Coordination with the Municipal Agriculture Office and the affected BDRRMCs.
- Municipal Agriculture Office conducted Rapid Damage and Needs Assessment (RDANA) to the affected barangays.

- e. Municipal Agriculture Office reported the affected barangays due to pest infestation of army worms "harabas" that results damages on onions.
- f. Bautista MDRRMC recommend and endorsed to the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan of Bautista for the declaration of state of calamity in the municipality due to pest infestations of army worms "harabas" that results crop damages on onions through MDRRMC Resolution No. 1 Series of 2018 and MDRRMC Resolution No. 2 Series of 2018 respectively.
- g. Sangguniang Bayan declared State of Calamity in the Municipality of Bautista, Province of Pangasinan through SB Resolution No. 172 Series of 2018 dated February 12, 2018
- h. Continuous monitoring of the Municipal Agriculture Office.

II. Food Poisoning in La Union

A. Situation Overview

- On February 15, 2018, a food poisoning was monitored at Sacred Heart School, Bauang, La Union.
- There were ten (10) victims and referred to Ilocos Training and Regional Medical Center (ITRMC), San Fernando City, La Union for further treatment and management.

B. Casualties

C. Actions Taken:

- Regional Epidemiology Surveillance Unit – Health Emergency Management Staff (RESU) coordinated the reported incident with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officers (LDRRMOs) and to the Department of Health (DOH) Hospital.
- OCDRO1 coordinated with the DOH and the Provincial DRRM Office of La Union and Municipal DRRM Office of Bauang, La Union for the situation update.
- OCDRO1 on continuous monitoring in the AOR.
