### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 8:00 AM, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at 455km East Southeast of Davao City, Davao del Sur (5.5N, 129.5E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over CARAGA, Davao Region and SOCCSKSARGEN. Residents in these areas must take precautionary measures against possible flashfloods and landslides and coordinate with their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.

Meanwhile, light to moderate rains is expected over Bicol region, Eastern and Central Visayas, and the rest of Mindanao.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hr Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 pm today and the next Weather Advisory will be issued at 11:00 am tomorrow.

However, you are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
