I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At **10:00 AM**, the **Low Pressure Area** was estimated based on all available data at **345 km West Southwest of General Santos City, South Cotabato or 180km South of Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur (5.3°N, 122.2°E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over **Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas and provinces of Surigao del Norte and Surigao del Sur**. Residents in these areas must take precautionary measures against possible flashfloods and landslides and coordinate with their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.

Meanwhile, light to moderate rains and thunderstorms are expected over the provinces of **Compostela Valley, Davao Oriental and Davao del Norte and rest of CARAGA**.


The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hr Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 pm today and the next Weather Advisory will be issued at 11:00 am tomorrow.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
