I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At **10:00 AM**, the **Low Pressure Area** was estimated based on all available data at **290km southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (7.8°N, 117.0°E)**. This weather system has **weakened but it is expected to bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Southern Palawan.**


With this development, this is the final advisory for this weather system.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
