#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At **8:00 AM**, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at 455km East Southeast of Davao City, Davao del Sur (5.5N, 129.5E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Caraga, Davao Region and SOCCSKSARGEN. Residents in these areas must take precautionary measures against possible flashfloods and landslides and coordinate with their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices.

Meanwhile, light to moderate rains is expected over Bicol region, Eastern and Central Visayas, and the rest of Mindanao.

The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-hr Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 pm today and the next Weather Advisory will be issued at 11:00 am tomorrow.
