**Progress Report re Fire Incident at Waterfront Manila Pavilion Hotel (NCR)**

**A. Situation Overview**

- At 9:52 AM, 18 March 2018, a fire incident occurred at the Waterfront Manila Pavilion Hotel. As of 11:30 AM, of the same day, the alarm reached Task Force Bravo.
- At 8:01 AM, 19 March 2018, the fire was under control. Also, at 10:56 AM, fire out was declared.
- The cause of the incident is still under investigation.

**B. Effects**

- A total of **seventeen (17) casualties** were reported. Of which, a total of **three (3) people were dead**, and **fourteen (14) were reported injured**.  
*Note: List of casualties are still for validation.*

**C. Actions Taken:**

- Manila DRRMO dispatched rescue teams and established an Incident Command Post (ICP).
- Manila DRRMO deployed its command van at Maria Orosa corner Kalaw St., Manila where all assisting responding units, and other rescue and response vehicles may report for deployment.
- OCD-NCR coordinated with BFP Fire District I (Manila) and Manila DRRMO regarding updates of the fire incident.
- MMDA with BFP-NCR and Manila MDRRMC held a press conference announcing the revival of the previously reported DOA and advised the motorists to refrain from plying the street where response operations are still ongoing.
