I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 11:00 AM today

Location of Center	1,740 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (6.0°N, 141.9°E)
Maximum Sustained Winds	55 km/h near the center
Gustiness	Up to 65 km/h
Forecast movement	West Northwest at 25 km/h

The Tropical Depression has no direct effect on any part of the country at the moment. However, it is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility between tomorrow afternoon (26 March) and Tuesday morning (27 March) and will be named "CALOY".

This weather disturbance is less likely to make landfall on any part of the country due to its recurving track.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 01** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
