The provinces of Albay, Sorsogon, Masbate and the regions of eastern Visayas, CARAGA and Davao will experience cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and isolated thunderstorms due to the Tail-end of a Cold Front and the trough of the approaching tropical disturbance starting Sunday (March 25) until Tuesday (March 27) while Metro Manila and the rest of the country will have warm and dry weather conditions associated with sunny weather, with chances of some isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms.

On Wednesday (March 28) until the duration of the forecast period (March 31), generally good weather condition apart from some isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms will prevail over the entire archipelago.

The coastal waters over the eastern section of the country will be moderate to rough throughout the outlook period while slight to moderate will prevail over the rest of the archipelago except during thunderstorms.

This outlook will be updated as soon as significant changes in the weather pattern occur.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level.
