SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Storm "CALOY" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR)

Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 550 km diameter of the Tropical Storm.

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "CALOY" was estimated based on all available data at 1,020 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (10.4 °N, 135.4 °E) .
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph
Forecast Movement:	Forecast to move North at 15 kph
