I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Storm "CALOY" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR)

Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 550 km diameter of the Tropical Storm.

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| Location of eye/center: | At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "CALOY" was estimated based on all available data at 1,020 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (OUTSIDE PAR) (10.4 °N, 135.4 °E) . |
| Strength: | Maximum sustained winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph |
| Forecast Movement: | Forecast to move North at 15 kph |
| Forecast Positions: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 Hour(Tomorrow evening): 1,100 km East Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (OUTSIDE PAR) (13.4°N, 135.5°E) • 48 Hour(Thursday evening): 1,260 km East Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (OUTSIDE PAR) (15.9°N, 136.2°E) • 72 Hour(Friday evening): 1,605 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (OUTSIDE PAR) (18.4°N, 138.6°E) • 96 Hour(Saturday evening): 1,975 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (OUTSIDE PAR) (20.2°N, 141.5°E) |

- 120 Hour(Sunday evening): **2,300 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (OUTSIDE PAR) (22.0°N, 144.1°E)**

With this development and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final warning for this weather disturbance

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 02 (Final)** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrant.
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
