I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At **10:00 AM today**, the **Low-Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **1,325 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.5 °N, 134.2 °E)**. This weather disturbance has no direct effect on any part of the country at the moment. However, it may develop into a **Tropical Depression** within **12 to 24 hours**.

The public and disaster risk reduction and management offices concerned are advised to **continue monitoring for updates**. The next update on this weather system will be incorporated in the 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow.

The next weather advisory will be issued at **11:00 AM tomorrow**.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
