I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"KARDING" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH WHILE MOVING GENERALLY NORTHWESTWARD."

"KARDING" will not make landfall in any part of the country and is expected to exit PAR between tonight and tomorrow morning (11 August).

Meanwhile, at 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area west of Extreme Northern Luzon has developed into a Tropical Depression and was estimated at 1,180 km West of Extreme Northern Luzon (19.7°N, 110.7°E) (OUTSIDE PAR) with maximum winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 75 km/h.

The Tropical Depression outside the PAR and Tropical Storm KARDING is enhancing the Southwest Monsoon (Habagat) which will bring scattered to widespread moderate to heavy rains over Batanes, Babuyan Group of Islands, Ilocos Region, Cordillera Administrative Region and the western section of Central Luzon beginning today. Residents of these areas, especially those living near river channels, in low-lying areas, and in mountainous areas, are advised to take appropriate actions against possible flooding and landslides, coordinate with local disaster risk reduction and management offices, and continue monitoring for updates. Meanwhile, the Southwest Monsoon will also bring scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Metro Manila, Mindoro Provinces, CALABARZON, and the rest of Cagayan Valley and of Central Luzon.


Sea travel remains risky over the western seaboard of Luzon.
