STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF LUZON (Ilocos Sur, La Union, Western Coast of Ilocos Norte, Pangasinan, Zambales, Bataan, Western Coast of Batangas, Western Coast of Occidental Mindoro Including Lubang Island, and Calamian Islands)	Monsoon rains	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Isabela, and Cagayan including Babuyan Islands)	Occasional rains	45 - 59/ 24 - 32	Rough	2.8 to 4.0

Fishing boats and other small seacrafts are advised not to venture out into the sea while large sea vessels are alerted against big waves.

You are hereby directed to still undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the Public, and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this advisory through local/community leaders and through your local media, including

community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.
