I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

24 March 2015

- The NDRRMC held a preparatory meeting in the observance of Semana Santa at the NDRRMC Conference Room attended by representatives from PAGASA, DSWD, DPWH, DOH, DepEd, DOST, DILG, DOTC, DENR, PAGASA, AFP, PNP, BFP, PCG, MGB, PIA, PRC, ICRC, NBI, MMDA, Project NOAH, CDP, DRRNet Philippines, and LPP
- Consequently, a memorandum was sent to all Chairpersons, RDRRMCs/OCD Regional Directors directing them to raise their respective operations centers' status to BLUE ALERT from 27 March to 06 April 2015, continuously monitor their respective area of responsibilities (AORs), report any untoward incidents to the NDRRM Operations Center, and undertake precautionary measures if situation warrants. Likewise, a memorandum was sent to NDRRMC Member Agencies to monitor, record, document, consolidate, and report all related incidents with various activities and actions taken by their agency and local offices in their respective AOR and to submit their preparedness measures report and the corresponding situational report/update thereon. A text message was also disseminated to NDRRMC Member Agencies and RDRRMCs/OCDROs to that effect

27 March 2015

- The NDRRM Operations Center raised BLUE ALERT on 27 March 2015 with representatives from member agencies rendering duty for prompt coordination, monitoring, and reporting within their specific AORs
- NDRRM Operations Center conducted meeting and press conference on Semana Santa 2015 at the NDRRMC Operations Center to present the member agencies' preparations for Semana Santa 2015

01 April 2015

- The NDRRM Operations Center upgraded alert status to RED ALERT.

II. INCIDENTS MONITORED (Tab A)

A total of **twenty-six (26)** incidents were monitored in Regions I, II, IV-A, IV-B, VIII, X and CAR. **Thirteen (13)** of this number were vehicular incidents, **nine (9)** were drowning incidents, **two (2)** were fire incidents, and **two (2)** other incidents.

III. CASUALTIES (Tab B)

A total of **19 individuals** were reported dead, **106 injured**, and **1 missing** in Regions I, II, III, IV-A, IV-B, VIII, and X.

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND ACTIONS TAKEN
Operations for SEMANA SANTA 2015
24 March - 08 April 2015

A. NATIONAL / NDRRMC

1. NDRRM Operations Center

- a. On 24 March 2015, issued a memorandum to all Chairpersons, RDRRMCs/OCD Regional Directors directing them to operate on a 24/7 Blue Alert Status effective on the same dates of the activation of the NDRRM Operations Center (27 March – 06 April 2015); and to monitor, record, document, consolidate, and report all related incidents with various activities and actions taken by local government agencies/offices and local DRRMCs in their respective areas of responsibility (AOR).
- b. On 27 March 2015, issued a memorandum to all NDRRMC Member Agencies directing them to monitor, record, document, consolidate, and report all related incidents with various activities and actions taken by their agency and local offices in their respective AOR.
- c. On 27 March 2015, 8:00 AM, the NDRRM Operations Center was activated and alert status was upgraded to BLUE ALERT STATUS to coordinate all efforts of government agencies for the observance of Semana Santa.
- d. Developed and distributed "Operations for Semana Santa 2015 Emergency Hotline" to NDRRMC Member Agencies and RDRRMCs/OCDRCs for reference and further dissemination.

2. Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA)

- a. Provided NDRRM OpCen with Weather Bulletins / Advisories
- b. Local PAGASA disseminated weather advisories to RDRRMC member agencies

3. Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG)

- a. Advised Provincial Directors, City Directors, and City/Municipal Local Government Operations Officers to coordinate closely with Local Chief Executives, Chief of Police, and Fire Marshalls to ensure their readiness to provide first response in case of emergencies.

4. Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)

- a. Ensured the deployment of personnel in bus terminals, air and seaports, and other areas of convergence.
- b. On 04 April 2015, DSWD Field Offices nationwide had standby funds and stockpile amounting to **PhP497,555,332.91**: Standby funds amounting to **PhP30,547,916.48**, family food packs worth **PhP175,887,573.46**, food items amounting to **PhP165,269,546.31**, and non-food items amounting to **PhP125,850,296.66**, with details as follows:

5. Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP)

Philippine Army (PA)

- 6th ID and 100 Brigade placed Response Team on standby for possible deployment.
- 1st ID, 4th ID, 2nd Mechanized Brigade, and 52nd Engineering Brigade and Tactical Operations Group (TOG) X placed all rescue assets and personnel on alert; ensured the provision of logistical support in terms of land transportation; and assisted in the maintenance of law and order.
- 503rd Brigade and 5th Division was placed on alert status and ensured the availability of back-up communication system (Harris communication equipment).

Tactical Operations Group (TOG) and PMA Disaster Response Task Group (DRTG)

- Placed on alert status.

6. Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)

- Directed all Regional Offices to activate their respective stations and to ensure the availability of fire, rescue, emergency, and medical personnel, apparatus, and auxiliary units.

7. Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP)

- a. Conducted inspection at Davao International Airport.
- b. Presented and tested their newly purchased fire truck in Davao International Airport as one of their preparedness measures during the observance of Semana Santa.

8. Department of Health (DOH)

- a. Raised Code White Alert in DOH-Central Office.
- b. All DOH Regional Offices raised Code White Alert; activated their Operations Center manned by Emergency Officers on Duty (EOD); standby medical teams were ready for deployment; coordinated with RDRRMC and DOH Provincial Offices; and continuously monitored for any untoward incident relative to Lenten Season.
- c. All 72 DOH Retained Hospitals have one (1) standby medical team each for Semana Santa 2015 .
- d. Health Emergency Management Bureau (HEMB) OpCen continuously monitored the situation and ready to respond in case intervention from DOH is needed .
- e. Escalated Code White to Code Blue Alert status in all Regions (I, II, III, IV-A, IV-B, V, CAR, and NCR) that affected by the typhoon (02 April 2015).

9. Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC)

- a. Implemented OPLAN Ligtas Biyahe.
- b. Mandated all its agencies to implement 24/7 operations for their respective action/operations centers in coordination with DOTC Action Center.
- c. Set-up help desks at major transport terminals.
- d. Provided additional reminders/guidelines/recommendations to agencies for maintaining passenger comfort and convenience.
- e. Adjusted the shifting of security, public affairs, operations, and maintenance/janitorial services personnel, and deploys additional manpower to better serve/assist passengers in airport terminals.
- f. Advised CAAP and the airport authorities to provide additional seats, as needed, in and around airport terminal buildings for passenger convenience.
- g. Directed Civil Aeronautics Board (CAB), CAAP, Manila International Airport Authority (MIAA), and the other airport authorities to ensure that all counters are properly manned during all operating hours.
- h. CAB conducted monitoring activities at NAIA Terminals and extended operating hours of CAB Help Desks at NAIA during weekends and holidays to assist passengers.
- i. Implemented measures to ensure passengers go through security screening at the Passenger Terminal Buildings (PTBs) prior to boarding their vessels.
- j. Advised maritime authorities to provide various amenities for passenger comfort/convenience, including: availability of first aid services on a 24/7 basis within ports; clean and properly maintained PTB facilities; drinking water; and portable toilets and extra tents/chairs as needed.
