: SEVERE WEATHER BULLETIN No. 01 RE: TROPICAL STORM "GLENDA"

Reference: PAGASA SWB No. 1 re TS"GLENDA" issued at 5:00 PM, 29 Aug 2010

1. Overview:

The Tropical Depression east of extreme Northern Luzon has intensified into tropical storm as it entered the Philippine Area of responsibility (PAR) and was named "GLENDA"

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "GLENDA" was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,050 km East of Extreme Northern Luzon
Coordinates	21.4°N, 134.°8E
Strength	Maximum winds of 65 kph near the center and gustiness up to 80 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move West Northwest at 19 kph
Forecast Positions	Tropical Storm "GLENDA" is expected to be at 790 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes by Tuesday afternoon.

This weather disturbance is still far to affect any part of the country.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next bulletin alert to be issued at 11:00 PM today.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
