**SUBJECT : SEVERE WEATHER BULLETIN NO. 04 for Tropical Storm "Glenda" (Kompasu)**

Tropical Storm "Glenda" has intensified as it moves toward the Southern Islands of Japan.

Location of eye/center as of 10:00 PM, 30 August 2010	880 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (24.0°N, 130.9°E)
Strength	95 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 120 kph.
Movement:	Forecast to move Northwest at 15 kph.
Forecast Positions:	Expected to be at 840 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes or 80 kms East of Okinawa, Japan, by tomorrow evening.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next bulletin to be issued at 11 PM today.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
