


1. Overview:

PAGASA Track as of 8 a.m., 31 August 2010

Satellite Picture at 10 a.m., 31 August 2010



Typhoon "GLENDA" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility and moving away from the country.

Location of eye/center (10:00 AM)	Typhoon "GLENDA" was located based on satellite and surface data at 830 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (25.5°N, 129.0°E)
Strength	Maximum winds of 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 150 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move West Northwest at 19 kph
Forecast Positions	Typhoon "GLENDA" is expected to be at 850 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes or 40 km North of Okinawa, Japan tonight.

Typhoon "Glenda" is expected to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over Northern and Central Luzon.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.


