1. Overview:

The Tropical Depression east of extreme Northern Luzon has entered the Philippine Area of responsibility (PAR) and was named "HENRY"

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "HENRY" was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,120 km East of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates	20.6°N, 134. 0°E
Strength	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move West Northwest at 22 kph
Forecast Positions	Tropical Depression "HENRY" is expected to be at 690 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow morning and at 510 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes by Sunday morning

This tropical cyclone is expected to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over Luzon and Visayas particularly the western sections.
