#### 1. Overview:

The Tropical Depression east of extreme Northern Luzon has entered the Philippine Area of responsibility (PAR) and was named "**HENRY**"

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression " <b>HENRY</b> " was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,120 km <b>East of Basco, Batanes</b>
Coordinates	20.6°N, 134. 0°E
Strength	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move <b>West Northwest</b> at 22 kph
Forecast Positions	Tropical Depression "HENRY" is expected to be at <b>690 km East Northeast</b> of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow morning and at <b>510 km North Northeast</b> of Basco, Batanes by Sunday morning

This tropical cyclone is expected to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over Luzon and Visayas particularly the western sections.
