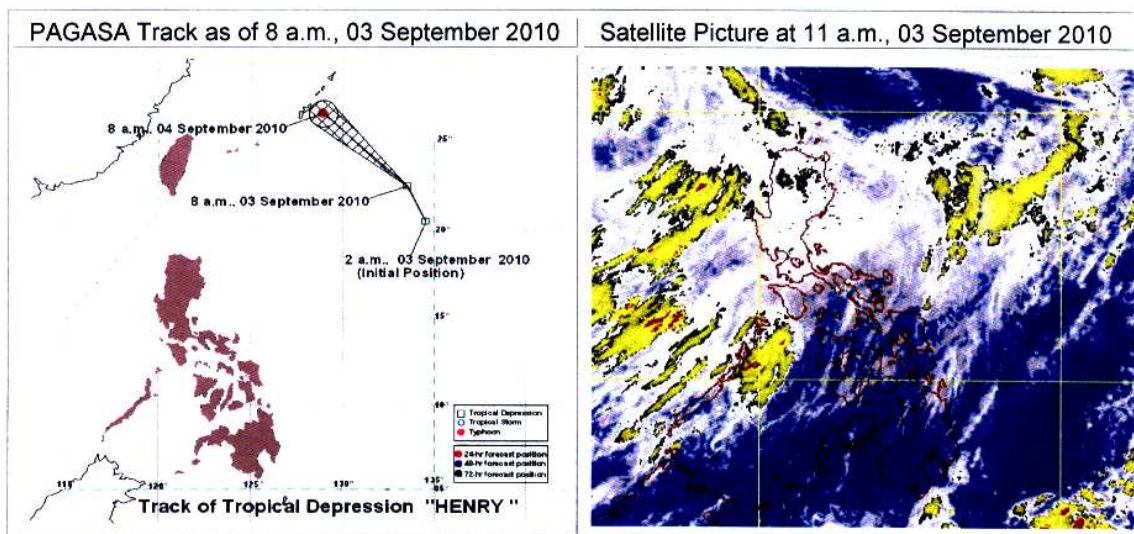

1. Overview:

The Tropical Depression "HENRY" has slightly accelerated as it moves toward the Southern Islands of Japan.



Location of Center: (as of 10:00 AM)	1,050 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes
Coordinates:	22.9°N, 133.1°E
Strength:	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center
Movement:	Northwest at 24 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Saturday morning: 850 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes or 110 km East of Okinawa, Japan

This tropical cyclone is expected to enhance the Southwest Monsoon and bring rains over Luzon and Visayas particularly the western sections.

2. Action/s Taken:

- NDCC-OPCEN prepared and disseminated NDCC Update for media and general public consumption and NDCC Advisory on Severe Weather Bulletin for Tropical Depression “Henry” and General Flood Advisory to all regions concerned through SMS, facsimile and website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster coordinating councils from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - NDCC-OPCEN is now on Partial Activation to monitor any situation update from the OCD Regional Centers likely to be affected by Tropical Depression “ Henry”
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
