**1. Overview:**

The Tropical Depression east of extreme Northern Luzon has entered the Philippine Area of responsibility (PAR) and was named "**HENRY**"

Location of eye/center	At 4:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression " <b>HENRY</b> " was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 1,120 km <b>East of Basco, Batanes</b>
Coordinates	20.6°N, 134. 0°E
Strength	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move <b>West Northwest</b> at 22 kph
Forecast Positions	Tropical Depression " <b>HENRY</b> " is expected to be at <b>690 km East Northeast</b> of Basco, Batanes by tomorrow morning and at <b>510 km North Northeast</b> of Basco, Batanes by Sunday morning

This tropical cyclone is expected to enhance the southwest monsoon and bring rains over Luzon and Visayas particularly the western sections.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next bulletin alert to be issued at 11:00 AM today.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
