A Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 130 km East of Surigao (9.0°N, 127.5°E). This weather system is expected to bring occasional to frequent rains over Visayas and Mindanao particularly over Surigao and Agusan Provinces which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

Residents in these areas are advised to take all the necessary precautionary measures.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
