**The Low Pressure Area (LPA) east of Catanduanes has dissipated as it approaches the Eastern section of Northern Luzon.**

**The weather system that will continue to affect Northern and Central Luzon is the tail-end of cold front that will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms becoming widespread rains over the eastern sections that may trigger landslides and flashfloods.**

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
