As of 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Bicol was estimated at 70 kms Northeast of Daet, Camarines Norte (14.5°N, 123.5°E). This weather disturbance will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over the whole country becoming occasional to frequent rains over Central Luzon and Visayas which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

Residents living in the above-mentioned areas were advised to take all the necessary precautionary measures against flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Coordinating Councils (DCCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
