Overview:

- **The Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Taiwan was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 490 km Northwest of Basco, Batanes (25.0° N 124.0° E). This weather disturbance will continue bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Northern and Central Luzon becoming widespread over extreme Northern.**
- Residents living in low lying areas and near mountain slopes are advised to take precautionary measures against possible flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to undertake monitoring of precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and DCCs concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
