As of 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 110 kms East of Tuguegarao City (17.6°N, 122.8°E). This weather disturbance will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Luzon becoming widespread rains over the northern and eastern section of Central Luzon which may aggravate floodings and landslides.

Residents living in these areas are advised to take the necessary precautionary measures.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
