### **1. OVERVIEW:**

As of 2:00 p.m. today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 570 km West of Mindoro (12.4°N, 115.7°E). Meanwhile, another Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 700 km East of Visayas (12.4°N, 131.5°E). These weather disturbances are embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Central and Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao bringing mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over these areas.

Residents living in these areas are advised to take the necessary precautionary measures.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
