A. Situation Overview

1. Background

- ❖ The intertropical convergence zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao from September 10-14, 2010 and active low pressure area (ALPA) triggered the occurrence of heavy rains and caused flooding and landslides in Koronadal City and Tupi, South Cotabato and Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat in Region XII and Davao City in Region XI

2. Effects

Affected /Evacuated population

- ❖ A total of 4,188 families /20,868 persons were affected, broken down as follows.

Casualties

❖ There were 12 casualties in South Cotabato due to landslide and flashflood, identified as follows:

5 Dead - Anita Patricio (28 yrs old), Rene Boy Patricio (10 yrs old), Micyla Patricio (4 yrs old), Linday Eres (80 yrs old) and Aira May Cabil (4 months old) all residents of Sitio Acub, Brgy San Isidro, Koronadal City, South Cotabato

7 Injured - Lito Eres Sulan (28 yrs old), Aileen May Tony (21 yrs old), Eris Ricardo Tacoyo (18 yrs old), Virginia Esminio (33 yrs old), Ronelo Cabil (20 yrs old), Leslie Patricio (10 yrs old) all of Brgy San Isidro, Koronadal City, South Cotabato and JM Valenzuela (6 yrs old) of Purok 9-A Brgy Poblacion, Tupi, South Cotabato

Damages

❖ The total number of houses damaged was 27 (7 partially and 20 totally) in Banga and Tupi, South Cotabato

❖ Twelve (12) hectares of fishponds and 27 hectares of rice and cornfields were damaged in Brgy el Nonok, Banga, South Cotabato amounting to PHP500,000.00

2. Actions Taken

❖ CDRRMC Koronadal, PDRMMC South Cotabato, OCD XII and DENR-MGB XII convened on September 11 and assessed the extent of damages and possible geological risk of the affected areas

❖ DENR-MGB declared Sitio Acub, Brgy San Isidro as danger zone for a week pending through risk assessment to be conducted by CDRRMC, PDRRMC and DENR-MGB XII

❖ CDRRMC Koronadal City convened on Sept 12, 2010 and recommended to the local Sangguniang Panlungsod the immediate declaration of State of Calamity

- ❖ PNP units from Regional, provincial and city Police offices were deployed for the conduct of search and retrieval operations of missing victims
- ❖ PDRRMC South Cotabato and CDRRMC Koronadal transported injured victims to the hospital for treatment
- ❖ PEO DPWH South cotabato conducted clearing operations at the national highway
- ❖ DSWD XII conducted stress debriefing to the victims in coordination with CDRRMC Koronadal
- ❖ CDRRMC Koronadal City and PDRRMC South Cotabato provided medical services to the injured victims and hot melas to all affected individuals
