2. 24 Hour Public Weather Forecast, Issued 5:00AM, 13 September 2010 -

SYNOPSIS: Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

FORECAST: Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao will experience mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms. The rest of Luzon will be partly cloudy to cloudy with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms mostly in the afternoon or evening.

Moderate to occasionally strong winds blowing from the east to southeast will prevail over Luzon and its coastal waters will be moderate to occasionally rough. Light southeasterly and variable winds will prevail over the rest of the country with slight seas except during thunderstorms.
