## I. OVERVIEW

At 10:00 AM Today, The Active Low Pressure Area (ALPA) was estimated at 870 km East of Mindanao (9.0°N, 135.0°E). The ALPA is expected to bring moderate to heavy rains (2.5 - 10.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms in Mindanao particularly over Lanao del Norte and the provinces of Agusan, Surigao, Davao and Misamis which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
