**I. OVERVIEW**

- The Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 530 KMS East Southeast of Hinatuan City, Surigao del Sur (7.2°N, 131.5°E).
- Meanwhile, the other Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 480 KMS East of Basco, Batanes (20.5°N, 127.0°E).
- These Low Pressure Areas and the Southwest Monsoon will bring scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Luzon and Mindanao becoming widespread rains over the Western sections of Northern and Central Luzon and the whole of Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.
- Residents living in low-lying areas and along the mountain slopes are advised to be on alert for possible occurrence of flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
