- I. OVERVIEW
  - At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 510 KM Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (13.9°N, 130.0°E). The LPA and Southwest Monsoon are expected to bring light to moderate rains (1.0-5.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms in Luzon and Visayas becoming moderate to heavy rains (5-10 mm/hr) over Panay and the provinces of Mindoro and Negros which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
