I. OVERVIEW

- At 11:00 AM today, The effect of the southwest monsoon has weakened but it still expected to bring scattered light to moderate rains(1.0-5.0 mm/hr) and thunderstorms over the western section of southern Luzon.
- Meanwhile, the Shallow Low Pressure Area(SLPA) has dissipated.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
