I. OVERVIEW

- The Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 450 km east of Borongan, Eastern Samar (11.8°N, 130.0°E). The other Low Pressure Area was estimated at 430 km East Northeast of Aparri, Cagayan (19.5°N. 126.0°E)
- These two Low Pressure Areas and the Southwest Monsoon will continue to bring scattered to widespread rains and thunderstorms over Bicol Region, Visayas and Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas as well as near the river systems in the affected areas and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.

You are hereby directed to undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the public and DRRMCs concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
