OVERVIEW

 The Low Pressure Area (LPA) over the vicinity of Palawan has dissipated. Meanwhile, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) will bring mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over Mindanao. With this development, this is the final advisory.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
