I. OVERVIEW

- **At 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on satellite and surface data at 440 km West of Calapan, Oriental Mindoro (13.7°N, 116.8°E) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) .**
- **The weather condition has improved for the past 12 hours and it is expected to have mostly cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms over the western section of Southern Luzon.**

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
