## I. OVERVIEW

- The Low Pressure Area (LPA) Northwest of Iba, Zambales has dissipated.
  Therefore, the weather condition has improved for the past 12 hours and it is
  expected to have partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or
  thunderstorms over Northern and Central Luzon.
- With this development, this is the Final Advisory.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let us untiringly aim for zero casualties.
